 - Master Plan and Develop Advisory Committee- No meeting but there will be a meeting tomorrow to vote on one item.
 - · Alumni Association National Board: No meeting
 - President's Executive Council: Policies were sent out to the Staff
 Council for input. Wording needed to be updated and the Human
 Resources links are being corrected.
 - Climate Study Working Group: An in person meeting was held for the focus groups. Staff had the most representation out of all of the groups. Please encourage staff to complete surveys when they receive

b) Vice-Chair – Jason Cory

- Faculty Senate: March meeting had several guest speakers. Dr. Franz explained that this fall the university will have an updated university syllabus that will contain all of the university wide standard information. This will eliminate the need for faculty to continuously update the wording on individual class syllabi. Dr. Hyatt spoke of the Day One Complete program that will allow students to have all of their textbooks charged to their accounts for the flat fee of \$20/credit hour. Students may opt out of the program however either they get all of their textbooks through the program for the semester or none. Reports were given on AOP12.12 and 12.30 with 12.39 rescinded. The April meeting Brent Fountain spoke concerning the GPAs of Athletes and Athletic teams. Chris Dallager spoke about the Student Support Office implementing new forms and trying to streamline processes. AOP 11.11,13.20, and 13.21 passed. Next year the new onboarding process for Faculty senators should be up and running. April 28, 2022 the general faculty will vote on the faculty rank policy. If it passes it will require an update to the P&T document and therefore there will be a May 6th special meeting to address this update.

- Information Technology Council: Adobe Sign will be available to all employees. A purchase of the Adobe Creative Cloud will be available for departments to purchase at a cost of \$150.
 - Duo is purging students after they are gone for two years.
 This will allow the university to stay under the total number of users allowed.
 - o ITS centralized governance is now making certain that all polices are being handled appropriately. It will have Centers of Excellence made of 5 committees such as classroom etc.

- **o** Due to supply issues several projects are being moved back.
- **o** The phishing campaign had 10% success across the campus. A new round will begin and include students. The goal is to raise awareness and help to avoid true phishing schemes.
- Remote login is now required to have 2 factor authentication for everything.
- **o** The annual security training had 72% compliance on the first round and 51% on the second round.
- ITS has procured a program that will allow ITS to update all computer systems owned by MSU.
