3. COMMITTEE REPORTS

- a) Chair Anna Webb
 - Master Plan and Develop Advisory Committee: no meeting
 - Alumni Association National Board: no meeting
 - Faculty Housing Appeals Committee : one appeal
 - President's Executive Council: The meeting was extremely short and simply to approve a motion discussed earlier.
 - Climate Work Study Group: MSU is conducting an institutional climate survey with the assistance of a third party to identify the strengths and weaknesses for inclusion on campus. If you receive an invitation from President Keenum to complete this survey, please do so completely and honestly. This survey will include many different cross sections of campus.

- **b)** Vice-Chair Jason Cory
 - Faculty Senate: The senate has found a way to allow remote attendance in meetings without changing the bylaws permanently, but instead by suspending the bylaw at each meeting. Dean Travis presented the benefits to attending the meetings in person. One policy concerning undergraduate university scholarships was discussed, however it was returned to committee. Two AOPs were addressed (1212 and 1306).
 - President's Committee on Planning: no meeting
 - Information Technology Council: The new firewall has brought to attention that two issues with remotely accessing computers on campus need addressing. First, the software to facilitate remote connections should be procured properly. Second, this process should have two-factor authentication. ITS does not currently have the work force to address all of the desired projects currently. With the new workflow process, if the job takes under 40 hours to complete it will still go through the ticket system. If it takes longer than 40 hours, it will be classified as a project and need forms completed and meetings with ITS.
